
Welcome back and 'Happy New Year' to everyone. I do hope you managed to relax and enjoy some family time over the Christmas break.


Staff News— We are very pleased to welcome Miss Andreea Caplat to our team at Griffe Field. Mrs Sharon Gahonia retired at Christmas and we wish her well for her future adventures.

Please name all belongings, it is much easier to return items when we know who they belong to. Hats and gloves are particularly useful at the moment, children are going out to play in the cold weather and Nursery/Reception still go outside for their learning.

Children are not allowed to wear jewellery to school. Simple stud earrings, an inexpensive watch and a Kara are allowed. Earrings and Kara must be removed (or covered) for PE and watches removed. Thank you.

Attendance and arriving on time is very important. We do reward the children for 100% attendance and also classes when they have 100% attendance in a week. We obviously rely on parents to bring their children to school <u>regularly and on time</u>. The gates open at 8.45am and classroom doors open at 8.50am. All doors and gates are locked at 9am. If your child is just 5 or 10mins late they have missed the teaching input for the first lesson of the day. Collection times for the end of the day are Nursery - 3pm, Reception - 3.10pm, Years 1 & 2 - 3.15pm and Years 3,4,5 and 6 - 3.20pm.





Years 1- 6, please send in a new glue stick for your child to use in school.

Alternatively use 'School Money' to purchase one via school for £1. Each child keeps their own glue stick in their pencil case. Thank you.

School uniform is <u>very important</u> and children are expected to come to school appropriately dressed <u>every day</u>. Please refer to the 'Uniform Expectations' sheets which has been shared numerous times on ParentHub. <u>PE days are NOT 'wear what you like' days!</u> <u>Backpacks are starting to appear again, they are not required</u>, they cause a health and safety issue as coats end up all over the floor in the corridors. A book-bag is the school expectation.
