| secondary colours | red + yellow=orange red + blue=purple blue + yellow=green |
| tints | A colour with some white added. |
| tones | A colour with some black added. |
| print | It can be used to make one or more identical images. |
| repeated pattern | A pattern that is repeated again and again. |
| mono print | An image is only printed once. |
