Vocabulary

Line	A line is a mark whose length is greater than its width. They can be straight or curved; they can be horizontal, vertical or diagonal; and they can change direction. Lines can be made with pens, pencils, paintbrushes and more.
Colour	Colour is the light that's reflected off an object. It has three main facets: hue, value and intensity.
watercolour	Watercolour is a special paint that uses coloured powders (pigments) mixed with water to make see-through (transparent) colours.
Undulations	Rising and falling.
Back ground	The furthest away from the eye. The first layer of the piece of art.
Collage	Collage refers to the actual procedures of cutting and pasting. It comes from the French word meaning, "to
