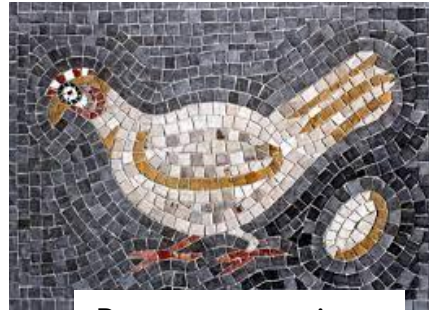

### Prior Learning

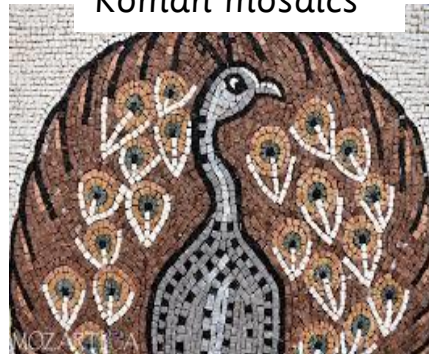
- Year 1 know how to use a combination of materials that have been cut, torn and glued.

### Vocabulary

collage	Collage refers to the actual art of cutting and sticking. It comes from the French word – to glue.
mosaic	A picture or pattern produced by arranging together small pieces of stone, tile, paper, etc.
tessellation	A pattern of two dimensional shapes that fit together without gaps.
texture	How something feels – rough smooth...
colour	The colour of something is the appearance that it has as a result of the way in which it reflects light.
tessera	An individual piece of mosaic.
bozzetto	A small scale mosaic.
