Vocabulary

imprint	A mark or outline made by pressing something on to a softer substance.
line	A line is a mark whose length is greater than its width. They can be straight or curved; they can be horizontal, vertical or diagonal; and they can change direction. Lines can be made with pens, pencils, paintbrushes and more.
overlay	A print layer laid over another surface.
rotated printed image	Where an image is printed, rotated and printed again.
reflective symmetry	Reflective symmetry is where a shape or pattern is reflected in a mirror line or a line of symmetry.
