



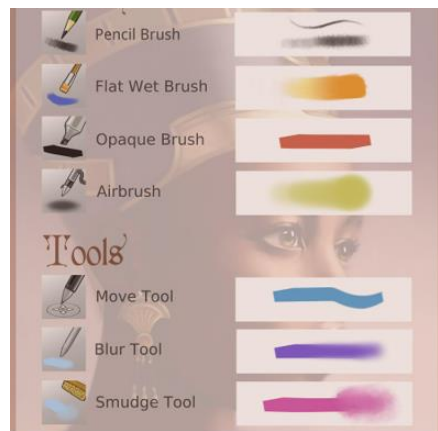
Year 5 Art: Digital Art Spring 2

Sticky Knowledge

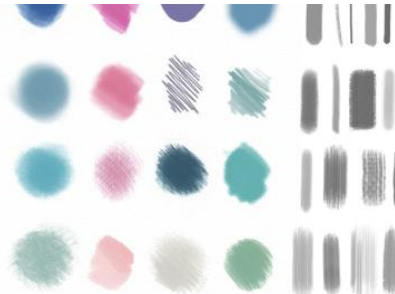
- I know how to use lines and fill tools plus copy/paste and rotation to create pattern effects.
- I know how to create shapes, fill, copy/paste, zoom and flip to create reflective symmetry effects.
- I can use stamps, copy/paste, layers and multiple frames to create animated GIF computer graphics.



Vocabulary

Rotation	Turn an object or objects to a point in a different direction.
Zoom	Move closer to the art work to add detail, such as adding small lights to a tower or facial features to a self portrait.
Symmetry	Copy an object or picture to make it the same on both sides.
Stamp	An object found in the software, such as a star, character etc which can be added to artwork digitally.
Flip	Make an object face the opposite way, this can be done vertically (left to right/ right to left) or horizontally (up to down/ down to up).
GIF	An animated set of images that are played on a loop.
