



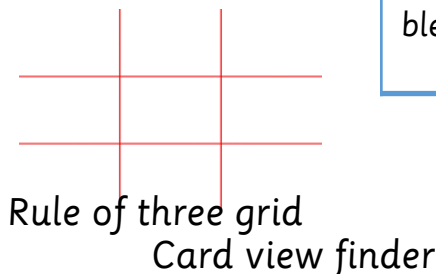
# Year 6 Art: Drawing/pastels –Rainforest Animals Spring

## Vocabulary

|               |   |
|---------------|---|
| composition   | The placement or arrangement in a work of art. How the picture is arranged.   |
| proportion    | Proportion describes the size, location or amount of one element in relation to another.                                  |
| rule of three | Splitting an image into thirds vertically and horizontally – allows you to place the subject off centre when you wish to. |
| view finder   | A frame which helps you to crop or select a particular part of a subject/image in order to concentrate upon this.         |
| back ground   | The part of the picture furthest away from the audience.  |
| foreground    | The part of a picture that is nearest to the audience.  |
| middle ground | The part of the picture that is in the middle between the background and foreground.                                      |
| blend         | Gently intermingling two or more colours to create a gradual transition or to soften lines.                               |
