

Rule of three grid
Card view finder

Vocabulary

composition	The placement or arrangement in a work of art. How the picture is arranged.
proportion	Proportion describes the size, location or amount of one element in relation to another.
rule of three	Splitting an image into thirds vertically and horizontally – allows you to place the subject off centre when you wish to.
view finder	A frame which helps you to crop or select a particular part of a subject/image in order to concentrate upon this.
back ground	The part of the picture furthest away from the audience.
foreground	The part of a picture that is nearest to the audience.
middle ground	The part of the picture that is in the middle between the background and foreground.
blend	Gently intermingling two or more colours to create a gradual transition or to soften lines.
