Vocabulary	
natural	Made by nature.
line	A line is a mark whose length is greater than its width.
observation	Looking closely.
pencil grade	Pencil grades tell you how light/hard and dark/soft a graphite pencil is. The H stands for hard and the B stands for blackness.
viewfinder	A viewfinder is a square/rectangle cut out of card that you can look through. Using a viewfinder helps you to focus on something.
