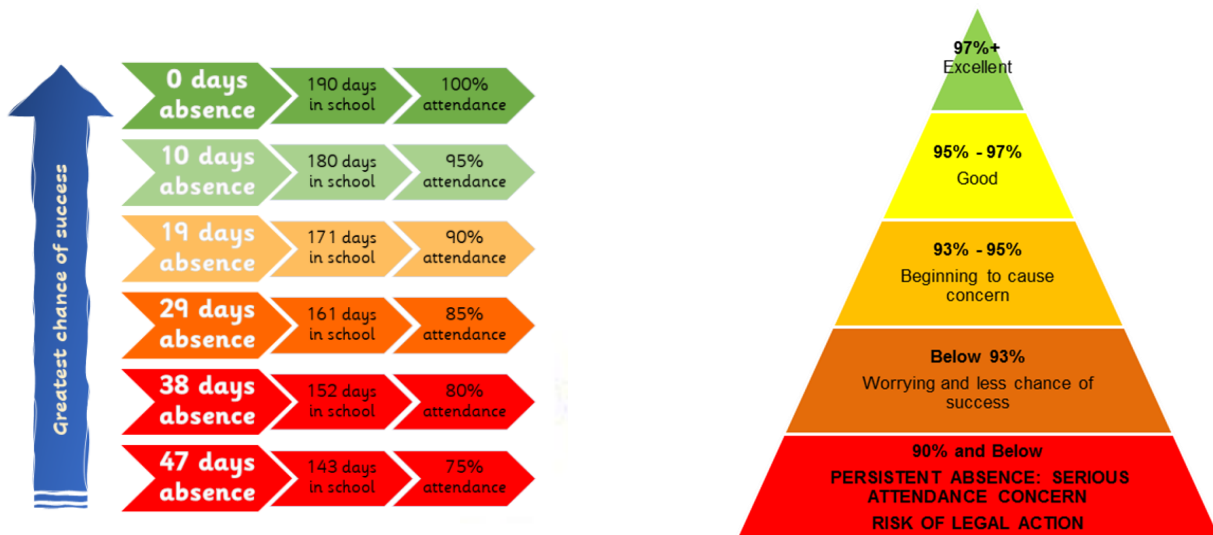


March 2022 Newsletter
