

In September collecting children will be slightly different in response to COVID-19. Today's newsletter explains the collection procedure in September.

The school gates will be opened at 3pm. Collection times are staggered. The time is linked to the CLASSROOM. When your child moves to their new teacher times may change slightly as the time is linked to the classroom to reduce congestion. Please collect your child/ren and leave the school grounds, following the one way system.

Nursery children will exit school through the Nursery door at 3pm	
Reception pupils will exit via the Reception doors from the Nursery garden area at 3pm	
1KW children will exit via door A at 3.15pm	1DW children will exit via door B at 3.15pm
2MR children will exit via the fire exit at 3.15pm	2SR children will exit via the fire exit at 3.20pm
3HM children will exit via door D at 3.20pm	3M children will exit via door D at 3.25pm
4H children will exit via door C at 3.25pm	4U children will exit via the fire exit at 3.20pm
5HW children will exit via door B at 3.20pm	5C children will exit via door B at 3.25pm
6F children will exit via the fire exit at 3.25pm	6D children will exit via door C at 3.25pm

You must collect your child/ren promptly and exit the grounds straight away please. Also, please stand behind the yellow markings when collecting children to ensure social distancing for staff and a clear walk way. If you are collecting older pupils please use playground 2 as a safe waiting area.

We will be operating a one way system on the playground. The path outside the Year 4 and 5 classrooms is not wide enough for the volume of traffic we have at school. If you are on playground 3 you CANNOT walk back to playground 1. You must either exit down the side of the Y2 classroom (this gate will be open and you will exit onto Grosvenor Drive), walk up the steps onto playground 2 and walk down the path, or use the back gate.
