Prior Learning

Children can...

- Move energetically using their strength, balance and coordination to perform skills such as running, jumping hopping, skipping, dancing and climbing.

- Throw and catch a ball over short distances and move a ball with control around their body.

Sticky Knowledge

Tag Rugby is a version of rugby which involves **tagging** instead of tackling. A special belt is worn with two **tags** attached to it which can be pulled off.



Dodging is a quick movement used to avoid a person or an object. This technique is often used in rugby to get past players to **attack** and score a **try** and avoid being **tagged** or tackled.

Twickenham is the national rugby union stadium of England and is where the national team play.



Twickenham Stadium is in the capital city of London.
