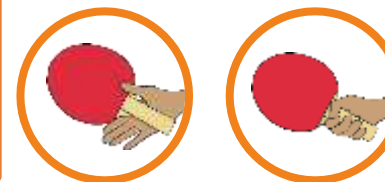


Vocabulary

- Bat, racket, handle, grip, ball, hit, strike, aim, target, catch, throw, roll, track, cooperate, distance, accuracy, control, height, practise

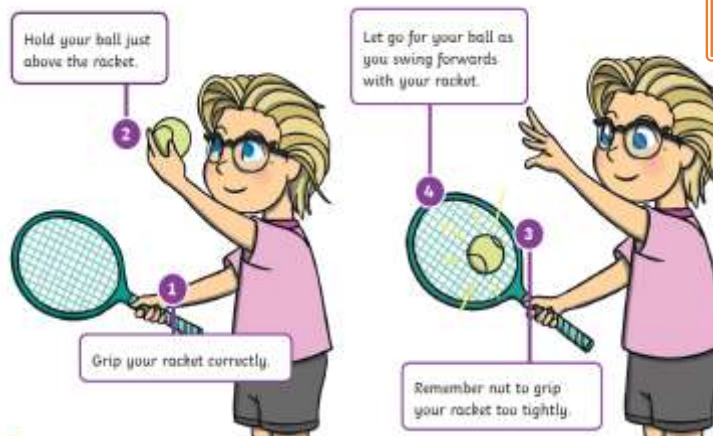
Did you know?
