## Sticky Knowledge



England women (Lionesses) won the European Championship final in 2022, bringing home the country's first major trophy since the men won the World Cup in 1966.



**Dribbling** is keeping control of the ball by having lots of little touches. You can use the inside, outside and top of your foot to **dribble**.

**Marking** is staying close to the **opposition** to stop them from moving into **space** to **receive** the ball.



**Passing** is an important skill in football. Your **team** keeps **possession** if they **pass** or **dribble**. You can **pass** using the inside, outside and top of your foot. You can **receive** a pass with **control** using the inside of your foot.
