- Participated in team games, developing simple tactics for attacking and defending.




Vocabulary

Sticky Knowledge



England women (Lionesses) won the European Championship final in 2022, bringing home the country's first major trophy since the men won the World Cup in 1966.



Dribbling is keeping control of the ball by having lots of little touches. You can use the inside, outside and top of your foot to dribble.

Marking is staying close to the opposition to stop them from moving into space to receive the ball.





Passing is an important skill in football. Your team keeps possession if they pass or dribble. You can pass using the inside, outside and top of your foot. You can receive a pass with control using the inside of your foot.
