Who is a Sikh and what do they believe?



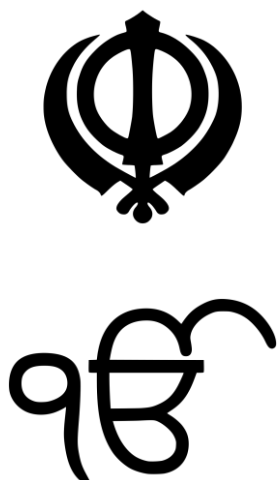
Prior Learning

| Kachera | One of the five Ks meaning underwear. |
| Kara | One of the five Ks meaning steel bangle. |
| Kirpan | One of the five Ks meaning small sword. |
