___ Sticky Knowledge

Handball is an invasion game played between two teams. It involves passing and bouncing a ball using the hands, trying to throw it into the goal of the opposition team.



A tactic in handball could be to move the ball quickly. Scoring opportunities develop when sharp, quick passes are made.

Using one hand to grip the handball is an important skill to have. Players receive passes using two hands.



The overhead pass is the most common way to pass the ball in handball.

Dribbling (like in basketball) can be used to move across the court to get towards the goal.



A double dribble (dribble, stop to hold ball then dribble again) will result in a turnover of possession — the other team will gain possession of the ball.
