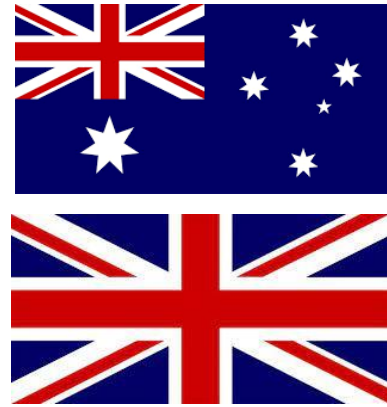


Year 1 Geography: Hot and Cold Countries

Prior Learning

- There are changes in weather in each season, summer being the hottest and winter being the coldest.
- The weather affects what we do and what we wear.
- Countries around the world have different climates.
- In a weather forecast, symbols are used to show what the weather will be like in a particular area.



Sticky Knowledge

- The seven continents are Europe, Africa, Asia, Australasia, North America and South America, Antarctica.
- The world's oceans are North Atlantic, South Atlantic, North Pacific, South Pacific, Indian, Arctic,
- Countries closest to the equator have a hotter climate
- Countries further away from the equator (closer to the north or south pole) are colder
- Australia is located in the southern hemisphere
- England is located in the northern hemisphere

Vocabulary

continent	A massive area of land that is separated from others by water or other natural features.
ocean	What you notice when you look carefully at something
Europe	The continent we live on
Australasia	The continent Australia is on
Physical features	Natural features of land
Human features	Features of the land that have been impacted by human activity
Landmark	A building or feature which is easily recognised
Equator	An imaginary line around the middle of a planet
Climate	the weather conditions in an area in or over a long period.
