Prior Learning


- Know that we live in Derby, which is in England

Key	Helps us understand map symbols
Landmarks	AN object or feature that stands our & is easily recognised
Local area	The area around where you live

Route	How you get somewhere
Symbol	A picture that represents a word. They are used on maps to make things clear and easy to find
