- Waves and water slowly erode the earth and wash it away. It is then deposited further along the coast
- The coastline is the fast eroding coastline in Europe



## Vocabulary

Attractions	a thing or quality that attracts people (beaches, arcades, amusement park)
Coastal	The land next to the ocean (seashore)
Harbour	An area of water where boats are kept that is protected from waves and currents
Cliff	A high, steep face of rock or earth.
Industrial	Businesses that provide products or services
Leisure	Time spent away from work relaxing.
Pier	A large platform on stilts that goes out into the sea. Blackpool has 3 piers.
Beach	The land at the edge of a lake, ocean or other body of water that slopes towards the water and usually has pebbles or sand.
Tourists	People who travel to a different place other than their home
Erosion	Wearing away of the earth's surface by wind or water.
Ocean	A large body of salt water
Deposited	To put down or place.
