Vocabulary

Attractions	a thing or quality that attracts people (beaches, arcades, amusement park)
fieldwork	Using maps to go out and about to get a practical understanding of something.
Land use	Land use is the term used to describe the human use of land.
Central Business District (CBD)	the main business and commercial area of a town or city.
Industrial	Businesses that provide products or services
Leisure	Time spent away from work relaxing.
Commercial Retail	To sell products to people
Tourists	People who travel to a different place other than their home
Residential	Areas where people live
