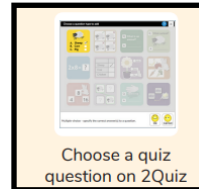


Year 2 Computing: Presenting Ideas (Information Technology)

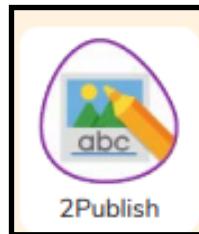
Prior Learning (Creating Pictures)

Key Vocabulary

| e-book | An electronic version of a printed book that can be read on a computer or electronic device. |
| fact file | A document containing important information about a subject. |
| fiction | Writing that is about imaginary characters and events. |
| non-fiction | Writing that is about real people or events, rather than stories which have been made up. |
| mind map | A way of organising and showing knowledge. It forms a web of connected ideas. |
| node | A way to show an idea using text and/or images. |
| quiz | A test of knowledge, often as a competition between individual people or teams. |
| presentation | A way of showing information about a subject to an audience. |
