## Why is Jesus inspiring to some people?

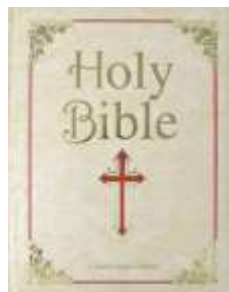
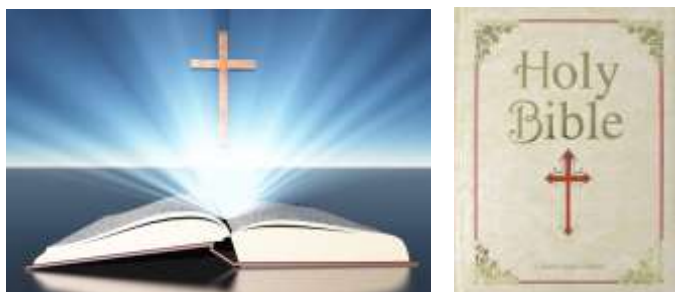
### Prior Learning

- Who is a Christian and what do they believe? (Year 1).
- Recognise and name symbols of belonging for Christians. For example, a cross, rosary, Bible.
- Have an understanding of who Jesus is and that Christians believe he is the son of God.



### Sticky Knowledge

- Make connections between some of Jesus' teachings and the way Christians live today.
- Describe how Christians celebrate Holy Week and Easter Sunday.
- Identify the most important parts of Easter for Christians and say why they are important (e.g. Palm Sunday, Good Friday, Easter Sunday).

| Parable   | Stories Jesus told with a special meaning.  |
| Holy Week | The last week of Jesus' life including Good Friday, crucifixion and resurrection.                 |
| Easter    | A Christian celebration.  |
| Crucifix  | A cross with the body of Jesus on it.   |
