Vocabulary

Jewish	People who follow the religion of Judaism.
Rosh Hashanah	A festival to celebrate the Jewish new year.
Yom Kippur	The most sacred and solemn day in the Jewish calendar. It is a day marked by prayer and fasting.
Pesach	A Spring festival celebrating the story of the Exodus, when the Israelites were freed from slavery in ancient Egypt by Moses.
Ten Commandments	Ten rules from God, given to Moses to help people live good lives and have a strong relationship with Him and each other.
Gratitude	Gratitude is a warm, happy feeling of being thankful for the good things in life. It means appreciating what you have.
