## Vocabulary

Jewish	People who follow the religion of Judaism.
Christian	People who follow the religion of Christianity.
Baptism	A Christian ceremony that welcomes people into God's family and shows they have chosen to follow Jesus.
Bar/Bat Mitzvah	A Jewish ceremony for a 13-year-old child, which marks them becoming a full adult member of the Jewish community.
Marriage	When two people join together in a special union and make a commitment to each other.
Commitment	Making a promise or firm decision to do something and then following through, even when it's hard, takes a long time, or you don't feel like it.
